# SPECIAL FELLOWSHIPS

### **Cain Graduate Teaching Fellowship, up to \$30,000 per annum**

Provides opportunities for a student to be mentored and gain experience in undergraduate instruction while pursuing a PhD. The student will receive special mentoring and have the opportunity to serve as instructor-of-record for one or more classes. The student will also participate in the workshops offered by the Center for Excellence in Learning and Teaching.

### **Cain Graduate Research Fellowship, up to \$30,000 per annum**

Provides opportunities for a student to gain additional research experience while pursuing a PhD. A mentor will be identified at a major industrial or governmental laboratory, and the student will spend periods working in-residence with that mentor.

---

### **Brookshire Fellowship, up to \$25,000 per annum**

This fellowship is provided by a generous donation from alumnus Dr. William Brookshire. The recipient must be a U.S. citizen with a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.50. Preference will be given to students who have demonstrated scholarship accomplishment and strong leadership skills, shown integrity and exemplary character, indicated a career preference for the private sector in the Process Industries, and who will be a good ambassador for the College and for the State of Louisiana.

### **Board of Regent's Fellow in Engineering, up to \$25,000 per annum**

This PhD fellowship is provided by the LSU Board of Regents. Minimum criteria include: GPA of 3.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale; and, acceptable verbal and quantitative scores on the GRE. These awards are highly competitive and award recipients are determined by a selection committee in the College of Engineering.

### **Flagship Assistantship, up to \$25,000 per annum**

This PhD research assistantship is provided by support from the LSU Graduate School. Students would also receive full tuition waiver as well as standard health insurance benefits.
